
Dear Langley Oaks Homeowners,

Over the past few months, several homeowners have asked about connecting to the natural gas line that is in parts of our neighborhood. I have met with Washington Gas to understand the current situation in the neighborhood. Facts are as follows:

- Of the 312 homes in Langley Oaks, 182 homes are on the natural gas main.
- 74 of the 182 homes are presently connected to the natural gas main.
- Homes on the following streets can choose to connect to the natural gas line:
 - Weatheford Ct
 - Baymeadow Ct
 - Heidi Ct
 - Heatherbrook Ct
 - Jill Ct
 - Deidre Ct
 - Ridge Drive from the entrance to 757 Ridge, in a clockwise direction
- Please contact Washington Gas for information of the requirements to connect to the nearest gas main to your home. James Conyers, Neighborhood Conversions Acct. Mgr. with Washington Gas is your contact. He can be reached at 703.750.5945 or jconyers@washingtongas.com.
- Homes not on the existing natural gas line can extend the gas line to their home. However the cost may be significant so ideally you will want to work together by streets to reduce the cost. Homeowners interested in this option should contact Washington Gas at the above number and coordinate with Mr. Conyers the Washington Gas Neighborhood Conversions Account Manager.
- Mr. Conyers is willing to meet with the individual street to discuss cost should your street require the gas line to be extended.
